Sadly this is not the case everywhere. Although governments are supposed to ban hateful speech, some abuse this power to pass laws criminalizing free speech in order to silence dissent. The reasons given often relate to religion, natural security or counter-terrorism. Freedom of speech has also been threatened recently by authorities suppressing NGO's, and activists.



'The ongoing protests come after a nationwide demonstration Thursday, when an estimated 250 million workers, farmers and their allies joined in what's believed to be the largest organised strike in history anywhere in the world. Organisers say tens of thousands of demonstrators have now gathered at each of New Delhi's three borders, in cold winter conditions....' Democracy Now, 2020

What started off as small-scale protests in August 2020 against three new farm ordinances approved by the government of India, would go onto to become the largest protest ever recorded. The government officially passed the ordinances into law in 27th September 2020 and claimed the new laws are aimed at giving farmers the freedom to sell directly to institutional buyers such as big trading houses, large retailers and food processors.

Farmers countered saying the laws will deregulate crop pricing and eventually, get rid of the Minimum Support Price (MSP) that guarantees them an income by setting a uniform price for certain crops. Most farmers are small-scale and have low annual incomes, not being in a position to take their produce out of their district to trade.

They believe in the long run a consortium of private players will develop, leaving them vulnerable to large corporations and market forces. In the law meant to provide for a governing mechanism for the contract farming, there seems to be no check upon the corporate houses coming into contract with the small peasants,

against usurping their land, also the dispute mechanism does not allow them to go to court. Similar developments have bought devastation on farming communities in several countries including the U.S.A and France.

Mass protests followed, culminating in hundreds of thousands of farmers and their supporters encamping around Delhi for over a year in makeshift tents. Large scale human rights violations were alleged to have been committed during this period including illegal detention, torture, and restriction of a free press and media.

In January 2020 alone the following occurred in relation to journalists were arrested:

January 17: Three journalists of the website 'The Frontier Manipur' were arrested under the UAPA and charged with sedition.

January 20: Senior journalist Paranjoy Guha Thakurta was issued a non-bailable arrest warrant by a Gujarat court.

·January 25: Three journalists in U.P.'s Kanpur Dehat district were booked for airing a report about a school function drill. January 28: FIRs were lodged against six senior journalists for inciting violence on January 26: through their social media posts. January 30: The Rampur Police in U.P. registered an FIR against senior journalist Siddharth Varadarajan.

January 31: Mandeep Punia was arrested by the Delhi Police at the Singhu border. Another journalist, Dharmender Singh, was picked up by police on January 30 evening from the border(20).

Farmer Labourers Activist Nodeep Kaur was also arrested on Jan 12th 2021. Geeta Pandey of the BBC, quoted Meena Harris's tweet that the activist was "arrested, tortured & sexually assaulted in police custody".

There was also a clamp down on social media. 'Twitter is locked in a battle with the Indian government after it was ordered to take down accounts supporting the ongoing farmers' protests. India's government has reportedly threatened to punish Twitter employees with fines and prison terms of up to seven years for restoring hundreds of accounts after the initial takedown'(26).

On 29 November, both Houses of the Indian Parliament passed the Farm Laws Repeal Bill, 2021: repealing the laws and paving the way for the farmers protest to end on 11 December 2021.


THE INDIAN FARMERS HUMAN RIGHTS REPORT

CHALLENGING ABSOLUTIST THINKING

Individuals are spurred to lessen self-uncertainty, explicitly sensations of vulnerability about their life, their future, and uncertainty about their self and personality. People often steer towards group identification. Social groups are depicted as prototypical entities, comprised of a collection of attributes, values, beliefs, emotions, and behaviours that define the group and its members, as well as differentiate them from other groups. The aim is to counteract and hinder the reinforcement of unprovable dogmatic beliefs, which can lead to radicalization and the proliferation of extremist ideologies. It is crucial to confront this type of absolute thinking.



STIMULATE general analytical and critical thinking, skills of observing; empathy; flexibility and adaptability. Uncertainty-identity theory

ENCOURAGE specific practical and rational thinking in the areas of self-reflection, Assessing / Reassessing extreme identity, ideology and other absolutist-held beliefs.


